

DIPLOMA OF WORK HEALTH AND SAFETY (BSB51319)

If you're looking to advance your career in workplace health and safety, the BSB51319 - Diploma of Work Health and Safety provides the advanced skills needed to manage and improve WHS systems across a range of industries.

You will develop skills in WHS risk management, incident investigation, consultation, compliance and the implementation and management of WHS systems.

This course consists of 10 units of competency, including 5 core units covering advanced WHS skills and 5 elective units covering compliance, emergency procedures, communication and leadership.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enrol into this course, the following requirements must be met:

- Completed all five (5) BSB41419 Certificate IV in Work Health and Safety core units or equivalent competencies.
- You must be 18 years of age or older at the time of enrolment and must have sufficient English language skills to complete the course.
- You should possess basic technological literacy and have access to the Microsoft Office suite or an equivalent software package.

COURSE DURATION

Students will have a maximum of twelve (12) months to complete the course.

DELIVERY MODE

Online / Self-Paced Study

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CAREER OUTCOMES

Completing the BSB51319 Diploma of Work Health and Safety equips you with advanced and transferable skills in workplace safety, risk management, incident investigation and WHS compliance. Potential career outcomes could include:

- Work Health and Safety Advisor: Provide advice and guidance on WHS systems, risk management and legislative compliance.
- Senior WHS Officer: Support and oversee workplace safety programs, risk controls and WHS compliance activities.
- WHS Coordinator: Coordinate WHS programs, consultation processes, incident management and safety reporting.
- Health and Safety Manager: Manage WHS systems, policies and processes and support continuous improvement in workplace safety.
- WHS Compliance Officer: Monitor organisational compliance with WHS legislation, standards, policies and procedures.
- Risk and Safety Advisor: Identify and assess workplace risks and recommend appropriate controls and improvement strategies.
- WHS Systems Coordinator: Support the development, implementation and maintenance of WHS management and information systems.
- WHS Consultant: Provide WHS advice and support to organisations on risk management, compliance and safety systems.



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Some roles may require additional industry experience or further qualifications. However, the BSB51319 Diploma of Work Health and Safety provides a strong foundation for progressing into specialist, senior and management-level WHS, safety, risk and compliance roles across a range of industries.
