

DIPLOMA OF QUALITY AUDITING (BSB50920)

If you're looking to advance your career in quality assurance, compliance or auditing, the BSB50920 - Diploma of Quality Auditing provides the practical skills needed to plan, conduct, lead and report on quality audits across a range of industries.

You will develop skills in audit planning, compliance, risk assessment, evidence collection and reporting, while also strengthening your communication and leadership capabilities.

This course consists of 12 units of competency, including 4 core units covering essential quality auditing skills and 8 elective units covering compliance, leadership and workplace effectiveness.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To enrol into this course, the following requirements must be met:

- You must be 18 years of age or older at the time of enrolment and must have sufficient English language skills to complete the course.
- You should possess basic technological literacy and have access to the Microsoft Office suite or an equivalent software package.

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CAREER OUTCOMES

- Compliance Officer: Help ensure an organisation operates in accordance with relevant legislation, standards, policies and procedures.
- Quality Assurance Manager: Oversee quality systems and processes and support continuous improvement across an organisation.
- Internal Auditor: Review internal systems, controls and processes to identify risks, non-conformances and areas for improvement.
- Audit Coordinator: Coordinate audit schedules, documentation, evidence collection, reporting and follow-up activities.
- Risk and Compliance Advisor: Assist organisations in identifying risks and maintaining effective compliance frameworks.
- Quality Coordinator: Support the implementation, monitoring and improvement of quality management systems.
- Compliance Coordinator: Assist with monitoring compliance obligations, maintaining records and supporting internal reviews.
- Continuous Improvement Coordinator: Identify opportunities to improve organisational processes, systems and performance.



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Some roles may require additional industry experience or further qualifications. However, the BSB50920 Diploma of Quality Auditing provides a strong foundation for progressing into quality auditing, compliance, risk and quality assurance roles across a range of industries.
